

What to do if your child develops COVID-19 symptoms

- **High temperature**
 - **New continuous cough**
 - **Loss of or changes to the sense of taste or smell**
1. You and your family must **stay at home and self-isolate**. Don't send your child to school.
 2. Organise a **COVID-19 test** by **calling 119** or order online at <https://www.gov.uk/get-coronavirus-test>
 3. **Contact your child's school** to let them know that your child has symptoms – either telephone the school office on 01858 464112 in school hours or out of hours email covidquestions@mha.learnat.uk.
 4. **POSITIVE TEST RESULT** –
 - i. **Contact the school immediately** either telephone the school office on 01858 464112 in school hours or out of hours email covidquestions@mha.learnat.uk.
 - ii. **Your child must self-isolate for 10 days** from the onset of symptoms and the rest of **the household must self-isolate for 14 days** – follow the guidance below.
 5. **NEGATIVE TEST RESULT** –

Your child can return to school if they feel well enough to do so and the rest of the family can stop self-isolating.
