

## Spanish Lessons at Market Harborough C of E



- Children working on learning objectives in line with the National Curriculum.
- Children's work follows the long-term plan.
- Activities match the learning question.
- Lessons begin with retrieval.
- Lessons will focus on key vocabulary and phonics.
- Each lesson contains a large amount of oracy.
- Teachers will use a variety of questioning techniques.
- Assessment for learning is embedded in the learning.
- Feedback is given throughout the lesson.
- The learning is broken down into small steps.
- Scaffolds and support are in place as necessary.
- Low stakes quizzes are used to assess understanding.
- Correct pronunciation is modelled by the teacher and is used by the children using the 'My turn, your turn' technique.
- Pictorial representations are used alongside key vocabulary.
