Our school

We offer:

- a dedicated and experienced EYFS (Early Years Foundation Stage) team to support you and your child in their first year
- the highest quality learning experiences for all children through our newly developed exciting curriculum
- a school where children leave in Year 6 having made strong progress compared to schools nationally
- specialist teaching in music where amongst other things all children learn to play the ukulele
- specialist PE teaching with our own Sports Coach
- Spanish lessons for all Key Stage 2 children
- a newly created ICT Suite with touch screen computers
- a woodland-themed, well-stocked library
- a fantastic teaching and learning space including playing fields and our very own nature garden
- a wonderful Forest School Site, our very own outdoor learning space where children have a chance to get back to nature: cooking, den making, having fun and getting very muddy!

Our school (continued)

We offer:

- a dedicated SENCO and team, the services of our own Speech & Language Therapist and access to our own Educational Psychologist
- a dedicated Pastoral Leader, there for you, to support you and your child. Concerns we have helped with include anxiety, toileting, and how to tackle homework
- a warm, friendly PTA who would welcome your involvement in helping to support the school
- delicious, healthy meals cooked on the premises using fresh local produce where possible.
 Don't forget every child in EYFS, Year 1 and Year 2 is entitled to a free school meal
- wraparound care:
 - Breakfast Club from 7.30am, serving a range of cereals, toast, pastries, fruit and yoghurts
 - After School Club from 3.15pm—4.30pm, offering a range of sporting or creative activities
 or a relaxing chillax session
 - Teatime Club from 4.30pm—5.30pm, where a light [buffet] tea is served

How to apply

Market Harborough C of E Academy is a non-selective Church of England School but where the Local Authority (Leicestershire County Council) controls admissions. If you would like to apply for a place in our school and you live in Leicestershire, the first step is to fill in a Leicestershire schools' admission application form. An easy way to apply is online at www.leics.gov.uk/admissions.

An application for a place in a primary school must be made to the Local Authority where you live. For example, if you live in Northamptonshire, you must still complete the Northamptonshire application form even if you intend to apply for a Leicestershire primary school place.

Our planned admission number for first time admissions (to start school in EYFS) is 60 pupils per year group.

We have a comprehensive induction programme for children starting EYFS, which includes:

- visits by our staff to see the children in their pre-school setting
- an information presentation evening to parents
- an informal 'getting to know you' tea party and opportunity for a 'taster' lunch for children and parents
- a series of taster sessions in school for the children, and
- an information booklet for children and parents to share
